## OVER FIFTIES FOURSOMES OPEN

### Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2010

**A 36-hole Stableford Foursomes Competition open to male playing members of recognised Golf Clubs who are over 50 years of age on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2010**

#### Conditions

1. Stableford Foursomes of two rounds. The stroke allowance shall be half of the combined handicaps. The combined playing handicaps of both players must not exceed 36. Up to date handicap certificates must be produced on the day; for 2010 inactive handicaps will be permitted.
  2. Order of play: Players driving at odd holes in the morning will drive at the even holes in the afternoon.
  3. In addition to the cup, prizes will be awarded to: **36 Hole Aggregate: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, 18 Holes am and pm: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>**. No pair will be awarded more than one prize.
  4. Ties will be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or final holes as may be necessary.
  5. Pairs must enter on the form below which should be returned with a **STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE and a Cheque for £98.00** made payable to West Hill Golf Club. In addition to two rounds of golf, this will include morning coffee & bacon roll, buffet lunch, prizes, and gratuities. ***Please note the Club's dress rules: Jacket and tie is expected of men in the main lounge and dining room. Short socks if worn with tailored shorts must be plain white without logo or adornment.***
  6. Entry, limited to 60 pairs, closes on **15 April 2010, or earlier if oversubscribed.**
  7. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry without assigning any reason and, if necessary, to replace players who have scratched after the draw has been published. Refund of entry fees post publication of draw will be at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
  8. Players may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect their play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
- NB Entries cannot be accepted for two West Hill members playing together.
